DARWIN


Darwin, known as Garramilla to the Larrakia Aboriginal people of the region, is a multicultural hub, harbour city, and the capital of the Northern Territory. A gateway city to the remarkable Arnhem Land, Kakadu and Litchfield National Parks and close neighbour of South East Asia, Darwin offers tropical, good-natured ambience with plenty of history and activity to discover.

Darwin retains a strong sense of frontier with Aboriginal, Asian and European influences, and its tropical climate with the distinct 'Wet' (November to April) and 'Dry' (May to October) seasons offers dramatic contrasts in landscape, making it a city quite unlike any other in Australia. Much of the city's offerings rest on the waterfront, making it the perfect place to enjoy leisurely waterside dining and spectacular sunsets.

Local markets are a large part of Darwin's personality. A selection of vibrant, colourful, and varied market experiences is on offer with street food, fresh fruit, artisan trinkets, live music and more. The most popular is Mindil Beach Sunset Markets which operate throughout the Dry Season. Discover Darwin's diversity and character with the backdrop of a stunning Darwin sunset by wandering through the hundreds of stalls on offer.

The city is known for its Aboriginal Art which is sourced all throughout the Top End. Available for purchase at local galleries or for viewing at the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory, Aboriginal Art covers a wide range of fascinating fields to discover including painting, weaving, and other mediums.

A fascinating destination in its own right, a stay in Darwin is filled with culture and character to discover while offering a convenient location into the rest of the Top End.

TOP END

The Northern Territory is vast. Occupying about one sixth of Australia's total landmass, its boundaries encompass a variety of contrasting landscapes and experiences. The Top End of the Northern Territory is known for its tropical weather, crocodiles, rich indigenous culture, great fishing, national parks and the laid-back lifestyle.


Uncover jagged peaks of towering escarpments that hide pockets of monsoon rainforest. Find waterfalls cascading into pools fringed with paperbarks, pandanus, and cycads. Browse through a gallery of ancient Aboriginal rock art at Ubirr or Nourlangie Rock, or explore the scenic Yellow Water.

Aboriginal people are the original custodians of the Top End and have a unique relationship with the land. Their art and Dreamtime stories weave a connection between spirit and country and give you a deeper understanding and insight to the mysteries of land and waters.

Darwin is the Northern Territory's multicultural capital. Soak up metropolitan Darwin by doing the markets at sunset, watching movies under the stars, cruising the harbour or taking a day trip out to Litchfield National Park; nature's very own water theme park.

Kakadu National Park, the largest national park in Australia, is situated 254 kilometres from Darwin on the Arnhem Highway. Renowned internationally for its natural and cultural wonders, Kakadu has one of the highest concentrated areas of Aboriginal rock art sites in the world.

Further south, the Katherine region is a network of rivers, escarpments, and gorges that weave through sprawling plains of cattle stations, national parks, and reserves. In Nitmiluk National Park, the mighty Katherine River slices through towering sandstone cliffs to form the world famous Nitmiluk Gorge.

Each activity is led and hosted throughout by specialist-trained, highly-knowledgeable guides who breathe passion for the region. The range of activities on offer are flexible, personalised to your interests and adapt with the feeling of each day, while personalised charter options can be organised in advance.

The lodge will offer generous respite after days of adventuring around the property and into the greater Top End. Amenities include a restaurant and bar serving locally-inspired meals made with flavoursome produce and uniquely Top End flavours, a lounge area, and an expansive deck with a plunge pool offering spectacular views of breathtaking Top End sunsets. Six exclusive rooms with flexible

configurations are on offer, each room with generous king split beds with an accompanying ensuite, complete with a deep bathtub. Interconnecting room options provide flexibility for families and whole-site bookings.

FINNISS RIVER LODGE

Experiences

Finniss River Lodge's abundance of activities are led by specially-trained guides to ensure a deep and immersive experience to remember. The range of activities on offer are seasonal and flexible, personalised to your interests and adapt with the feelings and conditions of each day. In addition, personalised charter options can be organised in advance.

Included in each guest's stay are two shared on-property activities per day, available as a morning and an afternoon experience. Morning tours usher you into adventure to explore the region in a lively way, with an emphasis on adventure, education and new experiences, while afternoon tours invite you to relax and bask in the stunning late afternoon light, the rays of the Golden Hour, and discover the diversity of stunning Top End sunsets.

Outside of the lodge, a broad variety of ecosystems invite you to wander through floodplains, beachfront, paperbark forests, remnant rainforest, giant termite mounds, and granite escarpment. Explore on foot, in an all-terrain buggy, by 4WD, or in an airboat while cruising upon tree-lined lagoons and natural waterways, with all stays three nights and over including a complimentary and exhilarating airboat cruise. The landscape offers a generous bounty to admire – whether enjoying a sundowner upon a scenic lookout, engaging in bush-

crafting adventures, walking through the landscapes, or tossing a line into the Top End's waters to seek out barramundi, be sure to keep an eye out for an incredible range of diverse birdlife, wildlife, and flora. Hands-on bush-crafting adventures will invite you to explore the landscape in a new way, including learning wilderness techniques to create fire and catch dinner with ancient techniques.

On-property, join the staff in their cattle-station work and learn about the day-to-day activities that make up looking after their herd of Brahman cattle, including exploring the open paddock bull yard, beef preparation, and seasonal cattle drives. Bush cooking demonstrations will invite you to explore food in a different way, while sundowners and canapés can be enjoyed across a variety of terrains both on- and off-site.

Pre-booked activities that you may be interested in include scenic heli-flights, fishing charters, and specialised touring into the Greater Top End, including touring through Kakadu and Litchfield National Parks.

With activities ranging from adventurous to educational to indulgent and everything in between, Finniss River Lodge can cater to travellers of all ages and ensure a memorable stay.

On-property activities include 4WD driving (vehicle and open-sided buggy), hiking, bush survival, hunting and gathering, wildlife spotting, birdwatching, sunset drinks and observing pastoral activities with the station owners or workers (this is seasonal, subject to availability and cannot be pre-booked).
